

UNION CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, May 26, 2020 – 7:30 P.M.
Leonard Almquist Council Chambers, 342 S. Main St, Union, OR 97883

This meeting was called to order at 7:37 p.m.

Roll Call: Councilor Leslie McMillan, Councilor Brian McDowell, Councilor Jay Blackburn excused, Mayor Leonard Flint, Councilor Susan Hawkins, Councilor John Farmer, Councilor Terra Richter, Student Liaison Emilee Freeman excused, and City Administrator Doug Wiggins.

Mayor Flint stated an item titled school fireworks would be added to the agenda after the Ranger Station item.

The first item on tonight's agenda was Resolution 20-13, Cybersecurity Policy. Councilor Hawkins read resolution for the record. Councilor Farmer motioned to approve the resolution. Councilor Hawkins second. Motion passed unanimously.

The next item was the Ranger Station, Asbestos abatement. CA Wiggins stated I requested bids on this and only got two. We continually asked for a bid from One Call and didn't get one until after another company submitted theirs. Both companies cover this area, the difference in the bid is based off One Call. Councilor Richter asked if either company gave an estimated time to begin the project. CA Wiggins answered Alpine said they would get on it quickly. With One Call, they didn't call us back after attempting to get them on the phone for a month. Councilor Farmer motioned to have the Alpine company do the project. Councilor McDowell second. Motion passed unanimously.

The last item on the agenda was the school fireworks. CA Wiggins stated tomorrow is the last day of school. Mr. Dunlap, the school principal asked if they could set off fireworks that night. It will be about a 15-minute show. It will scare animals, but no different than what you might have heard already. The Fire Department will be there. Council asked that a notice be put it on reader board during the day. Councilor Hawkins motioned to approve, Councilor Farmer second. Councilor Farmer voted no, on behalf of all dogs in the city. The motion passed.
