

**UNION CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**Monday October 26, 2020 - 7:00 P.M.**  
**Leonard Almquist Council Chambers, 342 S. Main St, Union, OR 97883**

This meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

Roll Call: Councilor Leslie McMillan, Councilor Brian McDowell, Councilor Jay Blackburn, Mayor Leonard Flint, Councilor Susan Hawkins, Councilor John Farmer, Councilor Terra Richter, and City Administrator Doug Wiggins.

The first item under old business was Resolution 20-20 which was tabled by Councilor Farmer. Mayor Flint stated this is 20 years old. It is not a matter of current events. It is required by the federal government.

CA Wiggins stated there was some civil rights protests and people died as a result of people being locked in a building that was on fire in 1990. I talked to Business Oregon and if the County Commissioners pass a resolution then we can refer to the County resolution. Councilor Farmer motioned to take Resolution 20-20 off the table. Councilor Hawkins second.

Councilor Blackburn read Resolution 20-20 for the record. Councilor Farmer motioned to accept Resolution 20-20. Councilor Hawkins second.

Councilor Blackburn asked so this passed in 1990. CA Wiggins answered yes, that is when this became required. We haven't had a grant like this one since 1990. Motion passed with 5 and one abstention from Councilor McDowell because he works for Business Oregon.

There was not any new business listed.

On public comment, Dick Middleton 10<sup>th</sup> Street stated I think we are confused on the water and sewer rate study; I hope you really look at this closely. We won't make money. I can't get it through my simple little mind.
